





Your GOALS must be Specific



Remember, developing good habits take time and effort. **Your Project** -The most common problem of the present day student is **reducing mobile phone usage**. Let us see how to start with Atomic Habit.

- 1. Set goal and reason for reducing mobile usage.
- 2. Identify the most used apps and prioritize reduction.
- 3. Set mobile free time during studies.

While doing

- 1. Share goals with friends and family.
- 2. Allow parents to monitor and control understand the consequence of excessive mobile usage.






Here are some famous Indian personalities who exemplify the principles from "Atomic Habits".

1. Small habits:

Ratan Tata (Businessman): Started his day with a 30-minute walk. Sachin Tendulkar (Cricketer): Practiced batting for 2 hours every morning. Narayana Murty (Infosys Co-Founder): Meditates for 30 minutes daily.



2. Consistency Over Intensity:

Milkha Singh (Athlete): Trained consistently for 10 years to become a world class sprinter. M.S. Dhoni (Cricketer): Trained consistently to become one of India's top cricketers. Kiran Mazumdar-Shaw (Biocon Founder): Works 12 hours a day, consistently.



3. Resilience:

J.R.D. Tata (Businessman): Overcame multiple setbacks to build Tata Group Kalpana Chawla (Astronaut): Faced rejection twice before becoming an astronaut Mary Kom (Boxer): Overcame adversity to become a world champion



Here are steps to help you stay away from social media:

Step 1: Prepare 1. Identify reasons for quitting/reducing social media

2. Set specific goals (e.g., reduce usage by 50%)

3. Choose replacement activities (reading, exercise, hobbies)



Step 2: Remove Temptation 1. Delete social media apps from phone/tablet

2. Uninstall social media extensions on browser

3. Remove social media shortcuts from homepage



Step 3: Block Access 1. Use website blockers (Freedom, Self Control, Cold Turkey)

2. Set screen time limits (iOS, Android)

A revolutionary system to get 1 percent better every day for 1 year will make 37 times better by the time we reach the goal. It's a continuous process, there's no finish line for it.

1 coin won't make anyone rich We need not pressurize ourselves but to be patient Adding another and another each day gradually sticking to the habit of saving in any circumstances Suddenly saving habit seems to be more easier... Never break the chain keep the habit streak alive



Prime Minister Narendra Modi ji success can be attributed to several good atomic habits.

- Early Rising and Yoga Practice: Modiji is known to wake up early, around 4:00 or 5:00 AM, and practice yoga to maintain his physical and mental well-being
- Disciplined Routine: He follows a strict routine, which includes dedicated time for work, exercise, and relaxation
