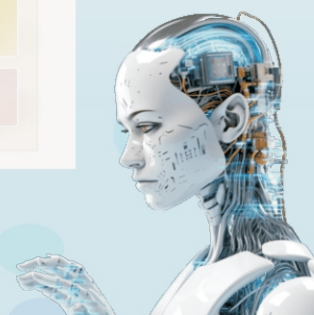
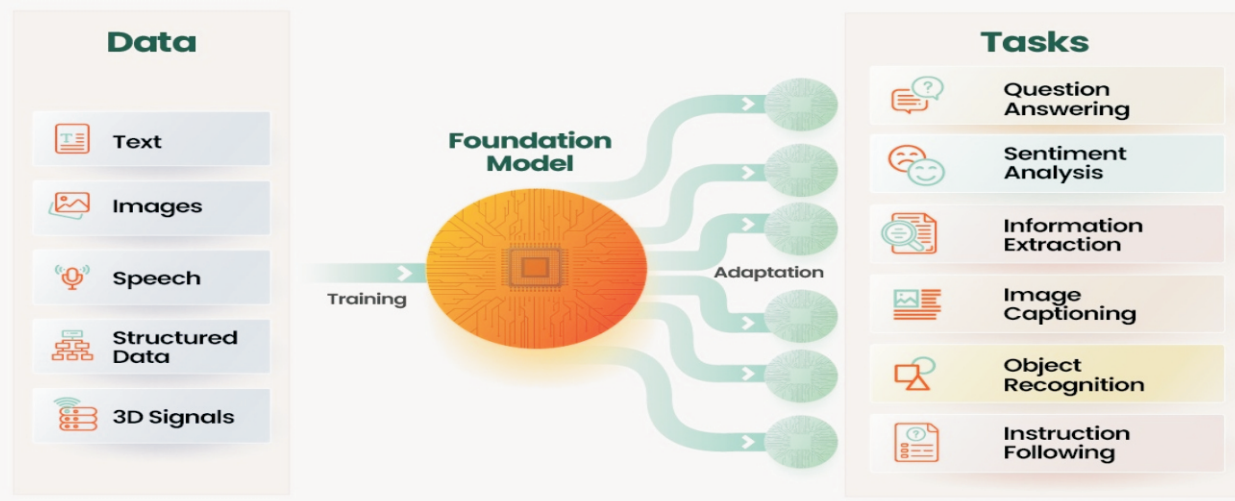
# Artificial Intelligence(AI) Applications

## Stages of AI Intelligence

The 7 stages of AI generally describe its evolution from basic programmed responses to hypothetical superintelligence, starting with Rule-Based AI, moving through Context-Aware, Domain-Specific, and Thinking/Reasoning systems, leading to Artificial General Intelligence (AGI), then Artificial Superintelligence (ASI), and culminating in the theoretical AI Singularity, where AI's growth becomes uncontrollable. These stages chart AI's increasing ability to learn, understand, reason, and eventually surpass human cognitive functions.
